As we look back over the past year, we have much to be proud of, from our 50th anniversary celebrations to our progressive, inclusive liturgies in person and online, our warm and welcoming community, and our many social and outreach activities. We continue to be a unique community of LGBTQI+ people and allies within the Roman Catholic tradition, where we can speak our truth without fear and be our whole selves.

As usual, we have a busy schedule of Pride activities planned. We will be participating in the Queens Pride Parade on Sunday, June 4. Our annual Pride Liturgy and reception will be held on Saturday, June 24, at 6:30 PM at St. John's. We are excited to share that our homilist will be Maddie Marlett, co-facilitator of the Dignity Young Adult Caucus. On Sunday, June 25, we will take part in our annual Witness at St. Patrick's Cathedral and then the NYC Pride March.

We come to you once again, as we do every year at this time, to ask for your financial support.
